




Automotive Bodyworks Apprenticeship Program Overview



Hazell Bros offers four-year Automotive Bodyworks apprenticeships, working on various mechanical plant, machinery and equipment.

As an apprentice with us, you would be part of a team working alongside experienced trades people assisting in repairs and restoration of fibreglass and / or metal components for industrial machinery and other equipment.

Our apprentices use a range of tools and assembly techniques to repair and restore mechanical plant, machinery and equipment to operational standards.

We require our apprentices to have a current driver's licence (or ability to get one), excellent communication skills, a willingness to learn and try new things, enjoy problem solving, be a team player.

At Hazell Bros we value diversity in all its forms, including gender diversity. We encourage applications from women to join our team.

PANEL BEATER

A hands-on apprenticeship to repair heavy vehicles, buses and trailer bodywork using specialised tools and techniques. Skills will be developed on and off the job learning under a qualified tradesperson.

Typical tasks include:

- Assisting the team with repairing and restoration of the body work of heavy vehicles e.g. trucks, buses, cars and trailers to their original condition.
- Carefully removing damaged panels and hardware, labelling parts, and reassembling the vehicle after repairs are completed.
- Repair damage by filling, straightening, and sanding panels and then refitting them onto the vehicle's framework.
- Cutting and joining.

Statewide travel may be required depending upon project location.

SPRAY PAINTER

A hands-on apprenticeship to learn how to apply industrial coatings to large items like light and heavy vehicles, trailers, machinery, and equipment, focusing on surface preparation, mixing and applying specialised paint and coatings, and using spray equipment within large industrial spray ovens.

Skills will be developed on and off the job learning under a qualified tradesperson.

Typical tasks include:

- Assisting the team with surface preparation, paint mixing and matching.
- Equipment Operation - mastering the use of modern industrial spray guns and other equipment to apply coatings evenly and efficiently to large and complex surfaces.
- Specialised coating application - applying protective coatings and finishes to prevent rust and corrosion on large metal structures or machinery.
