Typical tasks include:

- Transforming fabricated parts into objects and products
- Cut, shape and assemble and weld steel to construct and repair metal products and structures for steel structures
- Recognising faults, understand root cause and rectification
- Equipment maintenance
- Problem solve, design and manufacture solutions
